EDUCATION

PRIMARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION

Under current law, a school district required to provide transportation services to public and private school pupils enrolled in the school district are eligible to receive pupil transportation aid. The per pupil amount of pupil transportation aid for which a school district is eligible varies based on how far a pupil must be transported. 15

This bill makes an independent charter school that elects to provide transportation to pupils attending the charter school eligible for pupil transportation aid. This bill also increases the per pupil transportation aid amount for transporting a pupil who lives more than 12 miles from the school the pupil attends from \$275 per school year to \$300 per school year.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. 118.40 (2r) (dm) of the statutes is created to read:

2 118.40 (2r) (dm) The operator of a charter school authorized under this
3 subsection may provide transportation to pupils attending the charter school and
4 may claim transportation aid under s. 121.58 for pupils so transported.

****NOTE: Current law is silent with regard to transportation costs for pupils attending independent charter schools. I assumed it would be up to the operator to decide whether to transport pupils. Please let me know if this is incorrect.

5 SECTION 2. 121.58 (1) of the statutes is renumbered 121.58 (1) (a).

6 SECTION 3. 121.58 (1) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

7 121.58 (1) (b) Annually by the time the department prescribes under s. 121.08,
8 an operator of a charter school authorized under s. 118.40 (2r) that provides
9 transportation to and from the charter school shall provide a report to the
10 department that includes the number of pupils for whom transportation is provided
11 and any other information the department requires related to the transportation of
12 those pupils.

14 121.58 (2) (a) (intro.) A school district which provides transportation to and

16 school district that a pupil attends under s. 118.51 or 121.84 (4) which elects to
17 provide transportation under s. 121.54 (10), and an operator of a charter school
18 authorized under s. 118.40 (2r) that provides transportation under s. 118.40 (2r) (dm)
19 shall be paid state aid for such transportation at the following rates:

Hi Fern,

In response to draft 0627/P1, I have the following edits/comments:

- Your first note on page 2: You are correct that it should be up to the current operator to provide transportation for pupils.
- Your second note on page 2 regarding the reporting mechanism: I think the goal is for 2r charters to report/draw transportation aid in the same manner as public schools, but I don't see another spot in the statutes that require a report from 2r charter that would be similar to the school district report filed under 120.18. Does it make sense to just add language under s. 121.58 that creates a reporting requirement for 2r charters for "such information as the department requires on the number of pupils for whom transportation is provided"?

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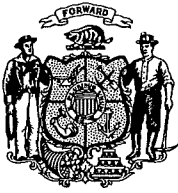
