

Hi Fern,

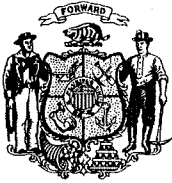
Could you redraft LRB 0632/1 to ensure that the testing requirement is only removed for the fall of 9<sup>th</sup> grade, not the whole of 9<sup>th</sup> grade? I don't think that we want to completely repeal ss. 118.30(1m)(ar), (1r)(ar), (1s)(bm) and (1t)(gm), just modify the language in those sections so that the language referring to "once in the fall session" is removed. Similarly, I don't think we want to amend 118.30(1) because there should still be a test administered in the spring of 9<sup>th</sup> grade.
