Couple questions on this one.

1. By gas tax, you are talking only about the motor vehicle fuel tax under s. 78.01, right?

2. While the motor vehicle fuel tax is generally deposited into the transportation fund under current law, under s. 73.03 (28) if the gas tax is delinquent then DOR can retain a certain amount to recover its costs of collection ("to pay contract and court costs"), with the remainder then going into the transportation fund. Do you want the motor vehicle fuel tax revenues pledged to exclude the amount that, under s. 73.03 (28), can be retained by DOR in recovering delinquent taxes?

Under current law, the Building Commission may issue revenue bonds for major highway projects and transportation administrative facilities. DOT may deposit in a special trust fund vehicle registration and titling fee revenues that are pledged for the repayment of these revenue bonds. Moneys pledged in excess of the amount needed for repayment of these revenue bonds are transferred back to the transportation fund, free of any pledge.

This bill allows DOT to pledge one-half of motor vehicle fuel tax revenues for the repayment of revenue bonds in the same manner as is allowed for other revenues under current law.
