Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau COMMERCE AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

BUSINESS ORGANIZATIONS AND FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS

Under current law, DFI regulates state-chartered banks, savings and loan associations, savings banks, and certain operations of the securities industry in this state. DFI also reviews and files charters, articles of incorporation, and other documents of business organizations and registers and oversees the mortgage banking industry. Finally, DFI oversees Uniform Commercial Code filings in this state and administers the Wisconsin Consumer Act.

This bill transfers all of the functions of DFI, including functions of the Division of Banking and the Division of Securities, to the Department of Financial + Institutions, Insurance, and Professional Standards (DFIPS). Additionally, his bill attaches the Office of Credit Unions, previously attached to DFI, to DFIIPS.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Under current law, DOA administers disabled veteran-owned business certifications, woman-owned business certifications, and minority business certifications that are designed to encourage the creation and foster the growth of Wisconsin businesses owned by women, disabled veterans, or minorities. A business that qualifies for and maintains one of those certifications may be eligible to receive certain advantages bidding on public projects and other benefits. This bill transfers the administration of those certifications to DFIIPS.

Also under current law, there is attached to DOA a Small Business Regulatory Review Board, which is tasked with reviewing and making reports concerning proposed administrative rules that may have an economic impact on small businesses. The Small Business Regulatory Review Board is advised by the Office of Business Development, which is also attached to DOA. The bill transfers the Small Business Regulatory Review Board and the Office of Business Development from DOA to DFIPS and venants the office of Business pevelopment

OTHER EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL AGENCIES

Under current law, the Educational Approval Board (EAB) inspects and approves private trade, correspondence, business, and technical schools to protect the students of those schools, prevent fraud, and encourage accepted educational standards at those schools. Currently, the EAB is attached to the TCS Board for administrative purposes. This bill attaches the EAB to the DFIMPS for administrative purposes.

EMPLOYMENT

Under current law, DWD performs certain administrative functions relating to worker's compensation. Those administrative functions include enforcement of the requirement that employers are insured for their worker's compensation liability; granting exemptions from that duty to insure to self-insured employers; administering the self-insured employers fund, from which DWD pays benefits to the injured employees of insolvent self-insured employers; administering the uninsured employers fund, from which DWD pays benefits to the injured employees of uninsured employers; and administering the work injury supplemental benefits fund, from which DWD pays supplemental benefits to certain injured employees with permanent total disability. This bill transfers the administrative functions of DWD relating to worker's compensation to DFIIPS.

Under current law, DWD performs certain adjudicatory functions relating to worker's compensation. Those adjudicatory functions include adjudicating disputed worker's compensation claims, adjudicating disputes over the reasonableness of fees charged for health services provided to an injured employee and of the amount charged for prescription drugs dispensed to an injured employee, and adjudicating disputes over the necessity of treatment provided to an injured employee. This bill transfers the adjudicatory functions of DWD relating to worker's compensation to the Division of Hearings and Appeals in DOA.

HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

OTHER HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

The bill transfers oversight of tattooing, body piercing, and tanning from DHS, which currently regulates those areas, to the new Department of Financial Institutions, Insurance, and Professional Standards (DFIIPS):

INSURANCE

OCI, which is headed by the commissioner of insurance, regulates the insurance industry in the state. The bill eliminates OCI and transfers all of the functions, except adjudicatory functions; employees; attached bodies; assets and liabilities; property; contracts; rules and orders; and pending matters of OCI to DFIIPS, which is created in the bill and headed by the secretary of DFIIPS. The bill transfers the adjudicatory functions of OCI to the Division of Hearings and Appeals in DOA.

SAFETY AND PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

Buildings and safety

No subtitle here

Under current law, DSPS and the various boards and councils attached to DSPS regulate professional licensure and buildings and safety in Wisconsin. This bill eliminates DSPS and transfers all of its functions to the Department of Financial Institutions, Insurance, and Professional Standards (DFI/PS). The bill attaches to DFI/PS the various boards and councils attached to DSPS under current laws

Under current law, DSPS administers the laws regulating private on-site wastewater treatment systems. Generally, a private on-site wastewater treatment system is a sewage treatment and disposal system serving a single structure with a septic tank and soil absorption field located on the same parcel as the structure. Current law also requires certain local governmental units to enact ordinances regulating private on-site wastewater treatment systems.

This bill transfers DSPS's responsibilities with respect to administration of the laws regulating private on–site wastewater treatment systems to DNR, except that the bill eliminates a grant program for individuals and businesses served by failing private on–site wastewater treatment systems.

STATE EMPLOYMENT

Finally, the bill requires the secretary of financial institutions, insurance, and professional standards to submit an organization plan to the secretary of administration for approval. The plan must specifically calculate the number of full-time equivalent positions, and the appropriation accounts from which these positions are funded, that are required to perform the functions of the DFILPS. Under the bill, the secretary of administration must review the plan and may adjust the number of full-time equivalent positions, and the appropriation accounts from which these positions are funded.


