NARRATIVE

The Department requests the creation of a new, continuing Postage Costs appropriation for the payment of agency postage costs; the transfer of \$11,556,300 PR-S in spending authority from s. 20.505 (1) (kL), Stats., to the new appropriation; and increased agency postage costs spending authority of \$4,581,600 PR-S and \$4,980,600 PR-S in the first and second year, respectively, for total postage costs authority of \$16,536,900 and \$16,536,900.

The Department currently provides for the payment of agency postage costs in s. 20.505 (1) (kL), Stats. Postal services are provided by and the costs paid to non-state postal service providers (i.e., they are pass-thru costs paid by the Department). The department neither establishes nor controls the postage costs. Revenue to the appropriation for these costs is provided by assessments to agencies for their portion of postage costs incurred. Postage costs paid from the appropriation have steadily increased from \$11,556,256 in FY 2007-08 to \$15,625,445 in FY 2013-14, and are expected to continue to steadily increase in subsequent years. This has resulted in the utilization of s. 20.505 (1) (kL), Stats., spending authority for postage costs in amounts greater than that which was provided for such purposes.

The Department requests the transfer of \$11,556,300 in spending authority from s. 20.505 (1) (kL), Stats., to a new, continuing Postage Costs appropriation to provide for needed flexibility to adjust the budget authority to reflect the actual amount of these pass-thru costs. The amount of the transfer is the Department's estimate of the base amount of spending authority in s. 20.505 (1) (kL), Stats., provided specifically for postage costs. \$16,137,900 and \$16,536,900 in authority is requested in the new Postage Costs appropriation for FY 2015-16 and FY 2016-17, respectively.

The bill creates a new continuing appropriation to DOA to fund state agency postage costs. The new appropriation consists of moneys transferred from an existing appropriation to DOA that pays the costs of providing state agencies with printing, mail processing, electronic communications, and information technology development, management, and processing services.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.505 (1) (ki) of the statutes is created to read:

20.505 (1) (ki) *Postage costs*. As a continuing appropriation, the amounts in the schedule to pay state agency postage costs. All moneys transferred from the appropriation account under par. (kL) shall be credited to this appropriation account.

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SECTION 2. 20.505 (1) (kL) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.505 (1) (kL) Printing, mail, communication, and information technology services; agencies. From the sources specified in ss. 16.971, 16.972, 16.973, and 16.974 (3), to provide printing, mail processing, electronic communications, and information technology development, management, and processing services, but not enterprise resource planning system services under s. 16.971 (2) (cf), to state agencies, and to transfer to par. (ki) the amounts in the schedule under par. (ki), the amounts in the schedule.

Hi Rick,

As far as statutory references are concerned, I think the draft would need to create one, as the Chapter 16 cross-references in (1)(kL) seem to largely tie to telecommunications and IT services. My understanding is that postage costs are incurred more under the printing/mailing part of DET but did not see any explicit references other than the appropriation.

The postage appropriation would receive revenue from charges to agencies for the respective amounts of postage costs incurred under (1)(ki). My understanding is that postage expenses are essentially pass-through costs – DOA contracts for an overall postage amount, which agencies then purchase based on need. Though DOA is incurring the overall postage contract cost, each agency is assessed by DOA for its portion of the overall postage cost. This chargeback model would continue to be used with the new appropriation.

Hi Rick.

Could the postage appropriation draft be modified to exclude the language referencing a transfer between ss. 20.505 (1)(ki) and (kL)?

Because (1)(kL) pays postage costs currently, the transaction reflected in Chapter 20 would decrease expenditure authority for (1)(kL) by the current postage costs amount and increase (ki) by that amount. Though it essentially is an initial transfer between appropriation, it is not intended for this to be a possible ongoing transfer between appropriations, which the drafted language currently seems to indicate.
