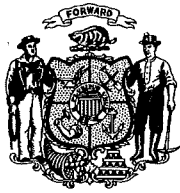
Modify current law to state that the Wisconsin Technical College System program fees that will be frozen on a per course basis in accordance with the high demand fields within each college district. The Department of Workforce Development will determine all high demand fields within each college district and promulgate this information to the Wisconsin Technical College System 30 days prior to the signing of the budget bill for the 2015-2017 biennial budget. Thereafter, the Department of Workforce Development will need to annually determine the high demand fields for each college district and promulgate this information by December 31st of each year to the Wisconsin Technical College System.

This draft freezes technical college system program fees established by the ~~state~~ board under s. 38.24 (1m), but not additional fees established by the district boards under s. 38.24 (1s). Is this consistent with your intent? WTCS (State) (STET)

(STET) Under current law, the ~~state~~ board establishes uniform fees for all technical college districts. I am not sure how this process works, but requiring the ~~state~~ board to freeze fees on a per-district and per-course basis may have administrative implications for the WTCS board. WTCS (STET)

I am also unsure when fees are established by the WTCS board for the next school year. Under s. 38.01 (9), "school year" is defined as July 1 to the following June 30. This draft does not include an initial applicability provision. Assuming that DWD's report is received by the WTCS board by August 1, 2015, I doubt that the WTCS board could freeze program fees for the semester that begins in the Fall of 2015, and I suspect that fees will already have been established for the entire 2015-16 school year. Do you want the bill to first apply to fees applicable in the 2016-17 school year or to fees applicable in the Spring semester of the 2015-16 school year?

Under current law, the state board establishes uniform fees for all technical college districts. I am not sure how this process works, but requiring the state board to freeze fees on a per-district and per-course basis may have administrative implications for the WTCS board.

I am also unsure when fees are established by the WTCS board for the next school year. Under s. 38.01 (9), "school year" is defined as July 1 to the following June 30.
