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

20.445 (1)(b), 106.27(1) identifies what the specific grant money can be appropriated for under the Wisconsin Fast Forward grants as--"the department shall award grants to public and private organizations for the development and implementation of workforce training programs. An organization that is awarded a grant under this subsection may use the grant for the training of unemployed and underemployed workers and incumbent employees of businesses in this state." The request changes the language to allow the department to also include the ability to promote the hiring and training of skilled apprentices.

EMPLOYMENT ✓

Under current law, DWD awards workforce training grants, commonly referred to as "Fast Forward grants," to public and private organizations for the training of unemployed and underemployed workers and of incumbent employees of businesses in this state. This bill permits an organization that is awarded a Fast Forward grant to use the grant for the hiring and training of apprentices in this state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 106.27 (1) of the statutes is amended to read: ✓

3 106.27 (1) WORKFORCE TRAINING GRANTS. From the appropriation under s.
4 20.445 (1) (b), the department shall award grants to public and private organizations

1 for the development and implementation of workforce training programs. An
2 organization that is awarded a grant under this subsection may use the grant for the
3 training of unemployed and underemployed workers and incumbent employees of
4 businesses in this state and for the hiring and training of apprentices in this state.
5 As a condition of receiving a grant under this subsection, the department may
6 require a public or private organization to provide matching funds at a percentage
7 to be determined by the department.

8 **SECTION 2.** 106.27 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

9 106.27 (3) ANNUAL REPORT. Annually, by December 31, the department shall
10 submit a report to the governor and the cochairpersons of the joint committee on
11 finance providing an account of the department's activities and expenditures under
12 this section during the preceding fiscal year. The report shall include information
13 on the number of unemployed and underemployed workers and, incumbent
14 employees, and apprentices who participate in training programs under sub. (1); the
15 number of unemployed workers who obtain gainful employment, underemployed
16 workers who obtain new employment, and incumbent employees who receive
17 increased compensation, and apprentices who obtain gainful employment or new
18 employment or who receive increased compensation after participating in such a
19 training program; and the wages earned by those workers and, employees, and
20 apprentices both before and after participating in such a training program. The
21 report shall also include information on the extent to which waiting lists for
22 enrollment in courses and programs provided by technical colleges in high-demand
23 fields are reduced as a result of grants under sub. (1g) (a), on the number of high
24 school pupils who participate in certification programs under sub. (1g) (b), and on the

1 number of persons with disabilities who participate in employment enhancement
2 activities under sub. (1g) (c).
