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

BUSINESS ORGANIZATIONS AND FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS

Under current law, DFI's general program operations are funded from an annual program revenue appropriation. From this appropriation, \$325,000 is transferred annually to an appropriation to the Secretary of State for general program operations.

This bill reduces the amount of the transfer to \$200,000 annually.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 **SECTION 1.** 20.144 (1) (g) of the statutes is amended to read:

3 20.144 (1) (g) *General program operations.* The amounts in the schedule for
4 the general program operations of the department of financial institutions. Except

1 as provided in pars. (a), (h), (i), (j), and (u), all moneys received by the department,
2 other than by the office of credit unions and the division of banking, and 88% of all
3 moneys received by the office of credit unions and the department's division of
4 banking shall be credited to this appropriation, but any balance at the close of a fiscal
5 year under this appropriation shall lapse to the general fund. Annually, ~~\$325,000~~
6 \$200,000 of the amounts received under this appropriation account shall be
7 transferred to the appropriation account under s. 20.575 (1) (g).
