Intent:

Modify language to define eligibility. Amend Section 45.60 (1)(a), Stats. to replace "deceased veterans and to deceased persons who served under honorable conditions in any national guard or in a reserve component of the U.S. armed forces" with "to eligible military members in the following categories:

- 1. Military personnel on active duty.
- 2. Former military members who served on active duty and were discharged under conditions other than dishonorable.
- 3. Members of the selective service.
- 4. Former members of the Selected Reserve and National Guard who served at least one term of enlistment or period of initial obligated service and were discharged under conditions other than dishonorable.

5. Former members of the Selected Reserve and National Guard who were discharged due to a service related disability.

Christopher,

Do you have any additional information on the request relating to the military funeral honors program (BB0323)? I'm not sure it's necessary to list all these groups.

- 1. A person killed on active duty is a veteran under s. 45.01 (12) (g).
- 2. A former active duty member who received an honorable discharge is a veteran under s. 45.01 (12) (a) to (c). This definition does require a specified length of service. Is the intent to extend the funeral honors to a person who served any period of active duty?
- 3. What exactly is meant by a "member of the selective service"? If it refers to a person who has been drafted into active service, they effectively become a member of group 2. As with 2, perhaps the idea is to grant funeral benefits to anyone who was drafted into service, regardless of the length of their service?
- 4. This one does confer a benefit to a group whose members would not currently be considered veterans.
- 5. A person discharged as a result of a disability is a veteran under s. 45.01 (12) (e).

I can certainly draft the list as requested, if the intent is to have a list. I just wanted to clarify that it may not be entirely necessary.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau VETERANS

Under current law, DVA administers a program to coordinate the provision of military funeral honors to deceased veterans and to deceased persons who have served under honorable conditions in any national guard or in a reserve component of the U.S. armed forces.

Under this bill, members of the following groups are eligible for military funeral honors: military personnel on active duty; former military personnel who received a discharge other than dishonorable; members of the selective service; former members of the selected reserve and national guard who served a term of enlistment or obligated service and received a discharge other than dishonorable; and former members of the selected reserve and national guard who were discharged due to a service—connected disability.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
