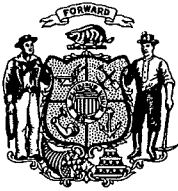

The bill adds substance abuse treatment services provided by a medically monitored treatment service or a transitional residential treatment service to other mental health and substance abuse treatment services paid for currently under the Medical Assistance program.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 49.46 (2) (b) 14m. of the statutes is created to read:
3 49.46 (2) (b) 14m. Subject to par. (bt), substance abuse treatment services
4 provided by a medically monitored treatment service or a transitional residential
5 treatment service.

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3 49.46 (2) (b) 14m. Subject to par. (bt), substance abuse treatment services
4 provided by a medically monitored treatment service or a transitional residential
5 treatment service.

1 **SECTION 2.** 49.46 (2) (bt) of the statutes is created to read:

2 49.46 (2) (bt) 1. For the purposes of par. (b) 14m., a “medically monitored
3 treatment service” is a 24-hour, community-based service providing observation,
4 monitoring, and treatment by a multidisciplinary team under supervision of a
5 physician, with a minimum of 12 hours of counseling provided per week for each
6 patient.

7 2. For the purposes of par. (b) 14m., a “transitional residential treatment
8 service” is a clinically supervised, peer-supported, therapeutic environment with
9 clinical involvement providing substance abuse treatment in the form of counseling
10 for 3 to 11 hours provided per week for each patient.

11 3. If approval by the federal department of health and human services of a state
12 plan amendment or waiver request is necessary for federal reimbursement of the
13 services under par. (b) 14m., the department is not required to pay for services
14 described in par. (b) 14m. if the department does not receive the necessary approval.
