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


Please draft a non-statutory provision requiring the Department of Health Services to seek a State Plan Amendment to its Childless Adults demonstration waiver to do all of the following:

(a) impose monthly premiums, as determined by the department; (b) impose premiums for risky behaviors, as determined by the department; (c) require a health risk assessment for all enrollees; (d) enroll childless adults for no longer than 48 months from date of eligibility determination; and (e) require a drug screening assessment as a condition of eligibility.

I have a few more changes for this draft. Please let me know if you have any questions about these changes or wish to discuss.

- ✓1. Please delete: line 3 "an amendment to the state Medical"; all of line 4 and line 5, "department of health and human services"
- ✓2. Please delete s. 49.45(23)(c). That language is now archaic because, since April 2014, the program only covers individuals up to 100% FPL. No one in the program currently pays premiums.
3. Line 10, page 1 – Please change the wording to "Impose higher premiums for enrollees who engage in behaviors that increase their health risks, as determined by the department."
4. Line 12, page 1, please change the word "coverage" to "eligibility" and on line 13, delete after the word "months." Then add that "The department shall specify the eligibility formula in the waiver amendment."

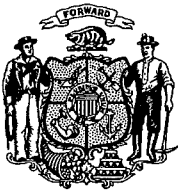
