The request will require minor modification to the language in the nonstatutory provision that is s. 9151 of 2013 Wisconsin Act 20. The following revisions are recommended under the definition of "approval" in s. 9151(2)(a)1:

"Approval" means approval by the <u>governor</u> secretary of the federal department of labor of a plan submitted jointly by the department of workforce development and the department of veterans affairs for transfer of the administration of the disabled veterans' outreach ...

Similar changes should be made to s. 9151(2)(b):

(b) Declaration and approval by governor Approval secretary of federal department of labor. The governor shall declare the department of veterans affairs is the primary service delivery system for veterans' employment. The department of workforce development and the department of veterans affairs, jointly, shall prepare a plan for transfer of the administration of the disabled veterans' outreach program and the local veterans' employment representative program from the department of workforce development to the department of veterans affairs and shall submit that plan to the governor secretary of the federal department of labor for approval. If the Upon approval of the plan by the governor secretary of the federal department of labor, administration of those programs shall be transferred from the department of workforce development to the department of veterans affairs as provided in paragraphs (c) to (i).

(1) Policy. It is the policy of the state to give provide health, educational, and economic assistance to veterans and their dependents who are residents of this state to the extent and under the conditions determined by the board department within the limitations set forth in this section.

Amend (10) Training and employment of veterans. The department shall operate programs in this state to enhance the employment opportunities of veterans of the armed forces of the United States, including the employment program funded under 38 U.S.C. Chapters 41 and 42. The programs must exclusively enhance the employment opportunities of eligible individuals, and the services provided under those programs must be provided by state employees. A state employee providing services under a program may only provide services to individuals eligible under the programs. The , in ecoperation with the department of workforce development and state selective service administration and any other federal, state, or local agency, shall cooperate with the department to formulate and carry out plans for the training and employment of veterans.


