#### **HIGHWAYS**

Under current law, with certain exceptions, DOT may not expend more than 1.5 percent of the project costs of any highway improvement project on elements that the department determines are primarily related to the aesthetic preferences of communities adjacent to the project (community sensitive solutions).



Under this bill, DOT may not expend any state funds for community sensitive solutions.


