Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This is a preliminary draft. An analysis will be provided in a subsequent version of this draft.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 13.101 (6) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

13.101 (6) (a) As an emergency measure necessitated by decreased state revenues and to prevent the necessity for a state tax on general property, the committee may reduce any appropriation made to any board, commission, department, or the University of Wisconsin System, or to any other state agency or activity, by such amount as it deems feasible, not exceeding 25% of the appropriations, except appropriations made by ss. 20.255 (2) (ac), (bc), (bh), (cg), and

SECTION 1

1	(cr), 20.395 (1), (2) (cq), (eq) to (ex) and (gq) to (gx), (3), (4) (aq) to (ax), and (6) (af),
2	(aq), (ar), and (au), 20.435 (7) (4) (a) and (7) (da), and 20.437 (2) (a) and (dz) or for
3	forestry purposes under s. 20.370 (1), or any other moneys distributed to any county,
4	city, village, town, or school district. Appropriations of receipts and of a sum
5	sufficient shall for the purposes of this section be regarded as equivalent to the

7	June 30. All functions of said state agencies shall be continued in an efficient
8	manner, but because of the uncertainties of the existing situation no public funds







- 2. Please amend (7)(b) to include "to fund activities in support of resource center operations" after s.46.283 (5) (as example: The amounts in the schedule for human services under s. 46.40, to fund services provided by resource centers under s. 46.283 (5), to fund activities in support of resource center operations, for...")
- 3. Please move (7)(bd) to program 4
- 4. Please eliminate (7)(da) and amend (5)(da), if necessary, to fund the activities from 7da.
- 5. We would like to move (7)(g) and 7hc into (4)(h). I realize that 4h language will need to be broadened here is a stab at that:

(h) BadgerCare Plus Childless Adults Program; intergovernmental transfer. All moneys received from any county to provide benefits under the demonstration project under s. 49.45 (23) for the purpose of providing the benefits. County Contributions: All moneys received from counties as contributions to the family care program under s. 46.2805 to 46.2895, the Pace program described under s. 46.2805 (1) (a), and the Wisconsin Partnership Program described under s. 46.2805 (1) (b), to fund services under the family care benefit under s. 46.284 (5) and services under the Pace and Wisconsin Partnership programs, and all monies received from counties under ss. 46.99 (3) and (3m) and 46.995, for an entity to administer and to pay for services provided under the birth to 3 waiver program under s. 46.99 and the disabled children's long-term support program, as defined in s. 46.011 (1g).
