Motion:

Move to prohibit the Department of Corrections from establishing or enforcing a policy on overtime if the policy results in overtime expenditures in the fiscal year greater than the amount of overtime compensation spent in the previous fiscal year, except as needed to make adjustments for inflation or salary increases that were based on cost-of-living increases.

Note:

This motion would incorporate the provisions of LRB-2169/1. Base funding for overtime in 2014-15 is \$34,033,800 GPR and \$1,510,900 PR.

2015 SENATE BILL 175

May 21, 2015 - Introduced by Senators ERPENBACH, GUDEX, HANSEN, VINEHOUT, RINGHAND, LASSA and BEWLEY, cosponsored by Representatives GENRICH, HESSELBEIN, KAHL, BERCEAU, OHNSTAD, BOWEN, POPE, SARGENT, BROSTOFF and SUBECK. Referred to Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety.

1 AN ACT *to create* 301.288 of the statutes; **relating to:** overtime policies at the
2 Department of Corrections.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill generally prohibits the Department of Corrections from establishing or enforcing a policy on overtime that results in the expenditure during the fiscal year of a greater amount of overtime compensation than was spent in the previous fiscal year.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 301.288 of the statutes is created to read:
4 **301.288 Policies regarding overtime.** The department may not establish
5 or enforce a policy on overtime if the policy results in the expenditure during that
6 fiscal year of an amount of overtime compensation that is greater than the amount
7 of overtime compensation spent in the previous fiscal year, except as needed to make
