Hello,

Tim Carpenter would like the following amendment drafted to the budget:

#### **Budget Amendment 1:**

Fix the funding differences for the cost to Milwaukee taxpayers to send a child through Milwaukee County Parental Choice program as through Milwaukee Public Schools. (AKA School Choice Funding flaw).

Under the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program (MPCP), the state pays for certain pupils to attend private schools located in the city of Milwaukee. For each pupil attending a private school under the MPCP, the state pays by a formula, which currently results in the total cost to the taxpayers (subject to MPS) more to send a student to a choice school. WI Chapter 121.08 (A similar budget amendment was previously drafted (2009 LRB 0592) but I believe that the formula has been changed since then.)

Tim would like the effect of his amendment would fix the flaw to make it cost the same (to MPS taxpayers) to send a student to MPS or a Choice school.
