**SENATE AMENDMENT 32,
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO SENATE BILL 21**

July 7, 2015 – Offered by Senators WIRCH, LASSA, HANSEN, CARPENTER, C. LARSON,
RINGHAND, BEWLEY, VINEHOUT, HARRIS DODD, ERPENBACH, RISSER and SHILLING.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1313, line 21: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 4299p.** 301.288 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **301.288 Policies regarding overtime.** The department may not establish
5 or enforce a policy on overtime if the policy results in the expenditure during that
6 fiscal year of an amount of overtime compensation that is greater than the amount
7 of overtime compensation spent in the previous fiscal year, except as needed to make
8 adjustments for inflation or salary increases that were based on cost-of-living
9 increases.”.

10 **2.** Page 1538, line 15: after that line insert:

11 “(1g) PRISON GUARD TOWER POSITIONS. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3)
12 of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of corrections under section

1 20.410 (1) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2015, the dollar amount is
2 increased by \$2,351,100 for the first fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which this
3 subsection takes effect to increase the number of FTE positions for the department
4 by 54.0 3rd shift tower staffing positions. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3)
5 of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of corrections under section
6 20.410 (1) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2015, the dollar amount is
7 increased by \$3,381,500 for the second fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which this
8 subsection takes effect to increase the number of FTE positions for the department
9 by 60.0 3rd shift tower staffing positions.”.
