AN ACT to repeal 25.46 (5L) and 287.31; and to amend 287.21 (intro.) of the statutes; relating to: the newspaper recycling fee and the recycled content of newsprint used in newspapers.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 25.46 (5L) of the statutes is repealed.
- **Section 2.** 287.21 (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

287.21 Statewide education program. (intro.) The department shall collect, prepare and disseminate information and conduct educational and training programs designed to assist in the implementation of solid waste management programs under ss. 287.01 to 287.31 287.27, enhance municipal and county solid waste management programs under s. 287.09 (2) (a) and inform the public of the
