2015 SENATE BILL 67

1	AN ACT to renumber and amend $115.415(1)$; to amend $115.385(1)$ (intro.); and
2	<i>to create</i> 115.385 (1m) and 115.415 (1) (b) of the statutes; relating to: pupil
3	assessments, evaluation of educator effectiveness, and school accountability
4	reports.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5 SECTION 1. 115.385 (1) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

6 115.385 (1) (intro.) Annually Subject to sub. (1m), annually by September, the

1 SECTION 2g. 115.415 (1) of the statutes is renumbered 115.415 (1) (a) and 2 amended to read:

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3 115.415 (1) (a) The department shall develop an educator effectiveness 4 evaluation system and an equivalency process aligned with the department's evaluation system for the evaluation of teachers and principals of public schools. 5 6 including teachers and principals of a charter school established under s. 118.40 (2r), 7 as provided in this section. Each Subject to par. (b), each school board and the 8 governing body operator of each charter school established under s. 118.40 (2r) shall 9 evaluate teachers and principals in the school district or charter school beginning in the 2014–15 school year. 10

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SECTION 2r. 115.415 (1) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

12 115.415 (1) (b) For the evaluation of teachers and principals in the 2014–15 13 school year, the school board and the operator of a charter school established under 14 s. 118.40 (2r) may not consider pupil performance on statewide assessments 15 administered under s. 118.30 in the 2014–15 school year and may not include pupil 16 performance on those assessments in the evaluation score assigned to a teacher or 17 principal under the educator effectiveness evaluation system developed under this 18 section.

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SECTION 4. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) Notwithstanding section 115.385 (1m) of the statutes, as created by this act,
the department of public instruction may include measures of pupil performance on
statewide assessment examinations administered under section 118.30 of the
statutes in the 2014–15 school year in the longitudinal data system maintained
under section 115.297 of the statutes.
