2015 SENATE BILL 164

1 AN ACT to amend 38.24 (3) (a); and to create 38.24 (3m) of the statutes; relating 2 to: charging resident fees to nonresident veterans and their family members 3 attending technical colleges.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4	SECTION 1. 38.24 (3) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
5	38.24 (3) (a) For Except as provided in sub. (3m), for all students who are not
6	residents of this state, nor subject to reciprocal agreements with the board, annually
7	the board shall establish a fee based on 150 percent of program fees established
8	under sub. (1m) (a) and (b).

1 38.24 (3m) NONRESIDENT FEE EXEMPTION FOR VETERANS AND THEIR SPOUSES AND $\mathbf{2}$ CHILDREN. (a) In this subsection, "covered individual" has the meaning given in 38 3 USC 3679 (c) (2).

(b) The district boards shall charge covered individuals living in this state the $\mathbf{5}$ fees established under sub. (1m) (a) and (b).

6 (c) If a covered individual living in this state is enrolled at a technical college, 7 and has been charged fees in accordance with par. (b), on the date that begins the 3rd 8 year after the veteran described in 38 USC 3679 (c) (2) (A) that is or is associated with 9 the covered individual was discharged or released from service, the covered 10 individual shall continue to be charged fees established in accordance with this subsection, rather than sub. (3) (a), for as long as the covered individual maintains 11 12continuous enrollment at the technical college.

13(d) This subsection does not affect any other fee exemption or fee remission for 14which a covered individual may be eligible under this section.

SECTION 3. Initial applicability.
