## 2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 100

March 12, 2015 – Introduced by Representatives JAGLER, WEATHERSTON, BORN, MURPHY, STEFFEN, A. OTT, EDMING, MURSAU, KOOYENGA, MURTHA and CZAJA, cosponsored by Senators S. FITZGERALD, FARROW, LEMAHIEU, LAZICH and OLSEN. Referred to Committee on Transportation.

1     **AN ACT** *to amend* 347.07 (2) (intro.); and *to create* 347.07 (3) of the statutes;  
2           **relating to:** lighting underneath motorcycles.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, unless expressly authorized or required, no person may operate any motor vehicle that displays any color of light other than white or amber to the front, nor any color other than red to the rear. This bill permits equipping a motorcycle with a lighting device that illuminates the ground directly beneath the motorcycle with a color other than red, blue, or green.
