Hi Mark. We are holding a hearing today on AB56, with an intention of the chair to move quickly on an executive session. In speaking with the UW system, there are some changes I would like to make.

- The system tells me they already have the information concerning the high school of the students taking the test. So we don't need to require it in statute.
- For privacy concerns, we would like to only require the information if there are more than six students at the high school who were required to take remedial classes. That number is the privacy threshold the UW System uses on all similar information disclosures.

1 AN ACT ~~...~~; relating to: University of Wisconsin System reports regarding
2 remedial courses in English and mathematics.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 36.11 (3m) of the statutes is created to read:

4 36.11 (3m) REMEDIAL COURSE REPORTS. (a) In this subsection:

5 1. "High school" means a school in this state in which the high school grades
6 are taught, including a school classified as a senior high school under s. 115.01 (2). ✓

7 2. "Placement test" means an English or mathematics placement test that is
8 required upon a student's admission to the system.

9 3. "School" means a public school, including a charter school^s as defined in s.
10 115.001 (1), and a private school, as defined in s. 115.001 (3r).

11 (b) By September 1 of each year, the board shall do all of the following:
