1 AN ACT to create 36.65 (5) of the statutes; relating to: University of Wisconsin
2 System reports regarding remedial courses in English and mathematics. ✓

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 36.65 (5) of the statutes is created to read:

4 36.65 (5) REMEDIAL COURSE REPORTS. (a) In this subsection:

5 1. "High school" means a school in this state in which the high school grades
6 are taught, including a school classified as a senior high school under s. 115.01 (2).

7 2. "Placement test" means an English or mathematics placement test that is
8 required upon a student's admission to the system.

9 3. "School" means a public school, including a charter school, as defined in s.
10 115.001 (1), and a private school, as defined in s. 115.001 (3r).

11 (b) By September 1 of each year, the system administration shall do all of the
12 following:
