Draft Request: Amendment to LRB-1299 (SB 80)

Eric -

Our office is seeking to have an additional amendment drafted for LRB-1299 (SB 80) to allow private companies, at the direction of and under contract with a public utility, to respond to service outages under the provisions of the bill.

For example, American Transmission Company (ATC) contracts with (a) public utilities and (b) other private contractors to perform service on the transmission lines it owns. While the current language of the bill covers the vehicle operations of the public utilities, I do not find it inclusive of private contractors.

Below in red is the suggested language we received from stakeholders, but I am unsure whether it abides by LRB drafting conventions. Please review and respond with your recommendation. Other suggestions are certainly welcome.

349.16 (3) (c) The authority in charge of the maintenance of the highway shall exempt from the special or seasonal weight limitations imposed under sub. (1) (a) a vehicle <u>operated by or at the direction</u> of a public utility, as defined in s. 196.01 (5), a telecommunications provider, as defined in s. 196.01 (8p), or a cooperative association organized under ch. 185 for the purpose of producing or furnishing heat, light, power, or water to its members, that is being operated for the purpose of responding to a service interruption.

Also, Representative Czaja will need the amendment for the Assembly companion, AB 122. Her staff, Emily Loe, is copied to this message should you have any questions.
