Hi Peggy,

I would like to make two changes to the language of AB 19, the GPS bill.

First, on line 6, section 1, sub-section (a), would it be possible to change the phrase "device on a vehicle" to "device on <u>or in</u> a vehicle"? Some committee members were concerned that "on" only referred to devices placed on the exterior of a vehicle (i.e. they thought this bill would apply to someone who puts a tracking device on the wheel well of a car, but not apply to someone who puts a tracking device in the glove compartment). I'm hopeful that adding "or in" or "or inside" would remedy this situation.

Second, and this is more of a general language change, would it be possible at places where the phrase "global positioning device" is used, to make it clear that cell phones may also be included under this bill? This change would affect section 1, sub-section (a) and section 1, sub-section (b). Basically, some committee members raised questions about whether a cell phone was, by itself, a global positioning device. While some cell phones are certainly capable of being used as a GPS because they contain GPS technology, they might not be considered a global positioning device. I don't know what the best way to illustrate that change would be, perhaps something

like, "a global positioning device or a device equipped with global positioning technology." This one could take some doing, so let me know what you think.

Thanks for your help, and let me know if you need any further clarifications!

February 10, 2015 - Offered by Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety.

1	AN ACT to create 940.315 of the statutes; relating to: unlawful use of a global
2	positioning device, and creating a penalty.
	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
3	<b>Section 1.</b> 940.315 of the statutes is created to read:
4	940.315 Global positioning devices. (1) Whoever does any of the following
5	is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor:
6	(a) Places a global positioning device on a vehicle owned or leased by another
7	person without that person's consent.
8	(b) Intentionally obtains information regarding another person's movement or
9	location generated by a global positioning device that has been placed without that
10	person's consent.
11	(2) This section does not apply to a motor vehicle manufacturer or a person,

acting within the scope of his or her employment, who installs an in-vehicle

subscription based communication or navigation telematics system, to a device installed by or with the permission of the vehicle owner for automobile insurance rating, underwriting, or claims handling purposes, to a law enforcement officer acting in his or her official capacity, to a parent or guardian acting to track the movement or location of his or her minor child or minor ward, to a lienholder or agent of a lienholder acting to track the movement or location of a motor vehicle in order to repossess the motor vehicle, or to an employer or business owner acting to track the movement or location of a motor vehicle owned, leased, or assigned for use by the employer or business owner.
