Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current law requires a register of deeds to collect certain fees. Among these fees are the following: For recording deeds, mortgages, land contracts, or satisfactions: \$30.

For recording subdivision plats, cemetery plats, or condominium plats, \$50.

For recording transportation project plans, \$25.

For copies of birth, death, marriage, or domestic partnership records: \$20 for the first copy and \$3 for additional copies.

For copies of recorded documents: \$2 for the first page, \$1 for each additional page, and \$1 for certification of the copy.

For recording documents and notifying the appropriate clerk of court related to certain transfers to survivors under probate: \$25.

For all other documents that are filed: \$30.

The bill increases the fee for recording documents related to transfers to survivors under probate by \$5 (from \$25 to \$30) and repeals the requirement that the clerk of courts be notified.

Based on data reported in the annual financial report filed by counties with the Department of Revenue (DOR), total register of deeds fees in 2013 were \$34,819,788. A breakdown of which fee generated this revenue is not included in the material reported to the DOR.

Based on data from the Office of Court Operations, an average of about 10,000 probate cases involving estates are filed annually. Assuming that all of these cases involve property transfers covered by the bill's fee increase, the annual statewide total of register of deeds fees by about \$50,000 (10,000 X \$5).
