1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 5, line 2 after that line insert:

3 "SECTION 2m. Nonstatutory provisions.

4 "(1) Before the 2018 application deadline for federal funds under Title X of the
5 federal Public Health Service Act, 42 USC 300 to 200a-6, the department of health
6 services shall conduct a study of the impact and feasibility of the department of
7 health services providing Title X services, which shall address all of the following
8 issues:

9 (a) Statewide service infrastructure, including identifying and securing local
10 providers.

11 (b) Potential service gaps.

12 (c) Impact on costs to consumers.

13 (d) Administrative costs compared to current service.
