

Good afternoon David,

Not sure which drafter to contact so I was hoping you may be able to help me get a P-Draft going. I think it should be pretty simple. Basically we want to allow safety monitoring equipment on windshields for use by commercial fleets and private citizens (for auto insurance coverage).

Amend 346.88 to add subsection (5):

This section shall not apply to safety monitoring equipment and driver feedback if mounted in either of the following locations:

- (a) Immediately behind, slightly above or slightly below the rearview mirror.
- (b) Where the rearview mirror would commonly be positioned if the motor vehicle is without a windshield mounted rearview mirror.

I think that should be a good start. We may have a few additions in the upcoming weeks. Let me know if you have any questions.
