2015 BILL

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 347.435 of the statutes; **relating to:** mounting a motor vehicle
2 monitoring device to the front windshield of a vehicle.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill allows a person to operate a motor vehicle that has a monitoring and feedback device mounted to the front windshield.

Under current law, no person may drive a motor vehicle upon a highway with any object so placed as to obstruct the driver's clear view through the front windshield. This bill allows a person to operate a motor vehicle that has a monitoring and feedback device mounted to the front windshield directly above, behind, or below the rearview mirror.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 347.435 of the statutes is created to read:
4 **347.435 Vehicle monitoring and feedback.** (1) Notwithstanding s. 346.88,
5 a person may operate a vehicle that has a device mounted to the front windshield if

Good afternoon David,

Not sure which drafter to contact so I was hoping you may be able to help me get a P-Draft going. I think it should be pretty simple. Basically we want to allow safety monitoring equipment on windshields for use by commercial fleets and private citizens (for auto insurance coverage).

Amend 346.88 to add subsection (5):

This section shall not apply to safety monitoring equipment and driver feedback if mounted in either of the following locations:

- (a) Immediately behind, slightly above or slightly below the rearview mirror.
- (b) Where the rearview mirror would commonly be positioned if the motor vehicle is without a windshield mounted rearview mirror.

I think that should be a good start. We may have a few additions in the upcoming weeks. Let me know if you have any questions.
