February 1, 2016 - Offered by Senator NASS.

- 1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
- 2 **1.** Page 13, line 20: after that line insert:
- 3 “SECTION 20m. 102.07 (6) of the statutes is repealed.”.
- 4 **2.** Page 31, line 4: after that line insert:
- 5 “SECTION 53m. 102.31 (1) (c) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:
- 6 102.31 (1) (c) 2. An intermediate agency or publisher referred to in s. 102.07
- 7 (6) of a newspaper or magazine may, under its own contract of insurance, cover
- 8 liability of ~~employees as defined in s. 102.07 (6)~~ persons selling or distributing the
- 9 newspaper or magazine on the street or from house to house for an intermediate or
- 10 independent news agency, if the contract of insurance of the publisher or
- 11 intermediate agency is endorsed to cover those persons. If the publisher so covers,
- 12 the intermediate or independent news agency need not cover liability for those
- 13 persons.”.
