## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill removes unused and outdated horse-racing provisions, and amends statutes to reflect current practices. This bill will:

- Change the deadline for the filing of financial reports.
- Give the fair the authority to limit the number of fairs an exhibitor may participate in and be eligible to receive a premium award from.
- Remove the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection and the Northern Wisconsin State Fair from having jurisdiction presiding over the other county and local fairs.
- Remove the limit on the amount of entry fees that may be charged to an exhibitor.

  As this bill will amend statutes to reflect current practices that have been in place for some time, there is no financial impact.
