SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO SENATE BILL 47

March 23, 2015 – Offered by Senator HARSDORF.

1	AN ACT to amend 7.15 (1) (cm); and to create 6.86 (7) of the statutes; relating
2	to: responding to a request for an absentee ballot.
	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
3	SECTION 1. 6.86 (7) of the statutes is created to read:
4	6.86(7) The clerk shall send or transmit an official absentee ballot no later than
5	the deadline provided under s. 7.15 (1) (cm).
6	SECTION 2. 7.15 (1) (cm) of the statutes is amended to read:
7	7.15 (1) (cm) Prepare official absentee ballots for delivery to electors requesting
8	them, and except as provided in this paragraph, send an official absentee ballot to
9	each elector who has requested a ballot by mail, and to each military elector, as
10	defined in s. 6.34 (1) (a), and overseas elector, as defined in s. 6.34 (1) (b), who has
11	requested a ballot by mail, electronic mail, or facsimile transmission no later than

the 47th day before each partisan primary and general election and no later than the 1 $\mathbf{2}$ 21st day before each other primary and election if the request is made before that 3 day; otherwise, the municipal clerk shall send or transmit an official absentee ballot 4 within one business day of the time the elector's request for such a ballot is received. $\mathbf{5}$ The clerk shall send or transmit an absentee ballot for the presidential preference 6 primary to each elector who has requested that ballot no later than the 47th day 7 before the presidential preference primary if the request is made before that day, or, 8 if the request is not made before that day, within one <u>business</u> day of the time the 9 request is received. For purposes of this paragraph, "business day" means any day from Monday to Friday, not including a legal holiday under s. 995.20. 10
