*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

4             **SECTION 1.** 94.72 (1) (im) of the statutes is created to read:  
5             94.72 (1) (im)   “Manufacturer” means any person who manufactures  
6             commercial feed.

7             **SECTION 2.** 94.72 (14) (a) of the statutes is renumbered 94.72 (14) (a) 2. and  
8             amended to read:

9             94.72 (14) (a) 2. A person manufacturer or distributor who knowingly violates  
10            this section or an order issued or a rule promulgated under this section ~~shall~~ may be

1 fined not more than \$200 \$5,000 or imprisoned not more than 6 months one year in  
2 the county jail or both. Any other person who knowingly violates this section or an  
3 order issued or a rule promulgated under this section may be fined not more than  
4 \$1,000 or imprisoned not more than 30 days or both.

5 **SECTION 3.** 94.72 (14) (a) 1. of the statutes is created to read:

6 94.72 (14) (a) 1. A person who violates this section or an order issued or a rule  
7 promulgated under this section shall forfeit not less than \$100 nor more than \$500  
8 for the first violation and not less than \$200 nor more than \$1,000 for any subsequent  
9 violation within 5 years.

10 **SECTION 4. Initial applicability.**

11 (1) This act first applies to violations committed on the effective date of this  
12 subsection, but does not preclude the counting of other violations as prior violations.
