Hi Elizabeth,

I don't think I've worked with you before, but I hope you can help me with a new drafting request.

I believe you were involved last session in the drafting of <u>2013 AB 397</u>, intended to clarify what types of battery-operated lights may be used while hunting certain species at night. Please produce a new draft of that bill—with one change. Under the bill, *firearm-mounted light* was to be defined as a light designed to be "mounted on the scope of a firearm." Instead, we would prefer that the new draft say "mounted on a firearm." In other words, we don't care where the weapon-mounted light is installed on the firearm.

Hopefully that gives you the guidance you need—but please feel welcome to give me a call with any questions.

Thanks in advance for your help!



This bill expands an exception to the prohibition in current law on using, or possessing with intent to use, a light for shining wild animals between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m. from September 15 to December 31 or while hunting or while in possession of a firearm, bow and arrow, or crossbow. Under the bill, a person may possess or use at the point of kill a handheld flashlight or a battery operated light designed to be affixed to clothing or a part of the body or mounted to a firearm while hunting on foot for wolves or for raccoons, foxes, coyotes, or other unprotected animals during the open season for the animals hunted.

Hi Elisabeth,

Thanks again for your work to draft LRB-3913/1 (for my office) and LRB-4248/1 (for Sen. Tiffany's office) recently.

Our companion bills are presently circulating for cosponsorship, and we've just learned of an opportunity for improvement. Rep. Al Ott's office explained that you have recently worked on a very similar draft for them, LRB-2874/2. That bill draft is nearly identical to ours, but it also removes wolves from the lists of species that may be hunted at night.

Please:

- 1) provide me with a new, introducible -3913/2 bill draft that, like Rep. Ott's draft, removes wolves from the lists of species that may be hunted at night; and
- 2) if possible, also draft an introducible amendment to -3913/1 that would achieve the same purpose. (Can you do that now, before I introduce the bill, or must you wait until it becomes AB ____?)

My goal is to provide Rep. Katsma with the option this week of EITHER introducing a clean bill that makes the change OR promptly amending -3913/1 after we introduce it.

Also copied on this email is Alivia from Sen. Tiffany's office. She will likely request that you take action on LRB-4248 similar to what you provide me on -3913.
