Hi Joe,

Senator LeMahieu would like to draft a substitute amendment to SB 295. We want the sub to combine 3 aspects:

1. 3675/5 – the substitute amendment Rep. Bernier has been working on for the online registration bill (Chad should be emailing you to give us drafting permission)
2. 3233/P4 – voter registration list and reporting absentee ballot information and election returns.
3. New language about ERIC:
 - **State authority on elections laws:** Affirms that Wisconsin is exempt from the National Voter Registration Act (AKA “motor voter”), and that joining ERIC would not require Wisconsin to abide by NVRA
 - **Privacy:** Prohibits ERIC from doing any of the following with data received from Wisconsin:
 - Sell or distribute the information to a 3rd party vendor for commercial, political, or any other purpose
 - Any other action not associated with administering ERIC or stipulated in the by-law agreement.

Give me a call if you have any questions. I know it’s a fast turnaround but we’re hoping to have this amendment ready sometime on Monday.
