**SENATE AMENDMENT 5,
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO SENATE BILL 295**

February 9, 2016 – Offered by Senator CARPENTER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 6: after “administration” insert “, regulating the production and
3 use of photo identification cards by certain local units of government,”.

4 **2.** Page 25, line 13: after that line insert:

5 “**SECTION 42m.** 6.34 (3) (a) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

6 6.34 (3) (a) 3. Any Subject to s. 66.0438, any other official identification card
7 or license issued by a Wisconsin governmental body or unit.”.

8 **3.** Page 51, line 17: after that line insert:

9 “**SECTION 104m.** 66.0438 of the statutes is created to read:

10 **66.0438 Limitations on locally issued identification cards. (1)**

11 DEFINITION. In this section, “public assistance benefits” means services, benefits,
12 payments, or other assistance provided under a program administered by the

1 department of health services or the department of children and families under s.
2 253.06 or ch. 49.

3 (2) TOWNS AND COUNTIES. (a) Except as provided in par. (b), no town or county
4 may issue, or expend any funds for the issuance of, a photo identification card for any
5 resident of the town or county.

6 (b) Notwithstanding par. (a), a town or county may issue, or expend funds for
7 the issuance of, a photo identification card to any of the following individuals or for
8 any of the following purposes:

9 1. An employee or elected official of the town or county, if the photo
10 identification card relates to the employee's or official's job duties.

11 2. An employee of a vendor or contractor that contracts with the town or county,
12 or an employee of a subcontractor that contracts with such a vendor or contractor,
13 if the photo identification card relates to the employee's job duties for the town or
14 county.

15 3. To use a transit system owned or operated by the town or county.

16 4. To use or access services or facilities owned by the town or county.

17 5. An employee of, or a student who is attending, an institution of higher
18 education that contracts with the town or county, if the photo identification card
19 relates to the employee's or student's job duties for the town or county.

20 (c) If a town or county has issued an identification card, other than a card
21 described in par. (b), that has been used before the effective date of this paragraph
22 [LRB inserts date], as an identification document to establish proof of residence
23 under s. 6.34 (3) (a) 3., that card is not valid for such purposes on or after the effective
24 date of this paragraph [LRB inserts date].

1 (3) CITIES AND VILLAGES. (a) If a city or village issues, or expends funds for the
2 issuance of, a photo identification card for any resident of the city or village, the card
3 must state clearly on its face, in 12 point type, “Not authorized for voting purposes.”

4 (b) A photo identification card issued by, or at the direction of, a city or village,
5 as described under par. (a), may not be used for any of the following purposes:

- 6 1. As an identification document to establish proof of residence under s. 6.34
7 (3) (a) 3.
8 2. As proof of identification under s. 6.79 (2), 6.82 (1) (a), 6.86, 6.87, or 6.875.
9 3. To obtain public assistance benefits.

10 (c) If a city or village has issued an identification card that has been used before
11 the effective date of this paragraph [LRB inserts date], as an identification
12 document to establish proof of residence under s. 6.34 (3) (a) 3., that card is not valid
13 for such purposes on or after the effective date of this paragraph [LRB inserts
14 date].”.
