Hi Tony,

AB-744 applies to the UW System, technical colleges, and private colleges.

For the UW, tuition and segregated fees would both be PR appropriations (but current law already prohibits the use of segregated student fees for any purpose other than that for which it was collected).

For technical colleges and private schools, there is no statutory appropriation.

Is it your intent to cover just the UW System or all schools? If the latter, we could add a provision that says something like, "An institution of higher education may

not use any moneys collected as tuition or student fees to pay for the cost of providing the letter" under subsection (2) [and also the financial literacy info. under sub. (3), if that is your intent].

Please let me know how you would like me to proceed.

TO ASSEMBLY BILL 744**

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 3, line 17: after that line insert:

3 “**(4)** SOURCE OF FUNDS FOR COMPLIANCE COSTS. An institution of higher education
4 may not use any moneys collected as tuition or student fees to pay for the cost of
5 providing any letter or financial literacy information under this section.”.
