Hi Rick ,

Rep. Sinicki would like an amendment to the effect that a local government running a municipal recycling program can petition the DNR (or is it DOA???) for an exemption from the bill for up to two years in order to enact a ban on either local use or sale of, or inclusion in the recycling stream of, a specific type or types of containers (e.g., all sizes of plastic water/soda bottles), but the exemption can only be granted if the local government shows evidence that they are unable to sell that recycled material for more than the amount of their recycling processing costs.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 3: before that line insert:

3 “SECTION 1d. 16.853 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **16.853 Auxiliary containers.** (1) The department may, upon application,  
5 grant a political subdivision, as defined in s. 66.0419 (1) (b), an exemption from the  
6 requirements of s. 66.0419 (2) with regard to a specific type of container if all of the  
7 following apply:

8 (a) The political subdivision describes in the application the type of container  
9 to which the proposed exemption would apply.

10 (b) The political subdivision demonstrates that it cannot sell the type of  
11 container at a price that exceeds the recycling processing costs of the container.

12 (2) The department shall specify the time period of an exemption under this  
13 section. The time period may not exceed 2 years.”.
