## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2015 Senate Bill 488 would create a program to protect the confidentiality of addresses for victims of domestic abuse, sexual assault, or stalking. DOJ assumes that 2 additional FTE would be required to fulfill the requirements of SB 488 -- 1.0 Community Services Technician and 1.0 Office Operations Associate. This bill would require the FTE to answer questions, review requests and handle mail. In addition, it assumes that 24,000 pieces of mail and the associated postage would be handled by DOJ.
