Relating to: commending the University of Wisconsin–Whitewater men’s basketball team for winning the National Collegiate Athletic Association Division III Basketball National Championship title.

Whereas, the University of Wisconsin–Whitewater Warhawks men’s basketball team earned its second NCAA Division III championship in the last three years and fourth in program history; and

Whereas, the Warhawks finished the season with a 29–4 record, including a 13–3 mark in conference play and a perfect 15–0 tally at home; and

Whereas, the Warhawks won the final on Quardell Young’s driving layup in the closing second of regulation, sealing a 75–73 victory over Williams College; and
