Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill provides for permanent revocation of a person's operating privilege if the person commits certain OWI offenses. The bill would change the existing calculations done relating to OWI offenses for revocations, occupational license eligibility, and reinstatement eligibility. Since these calculations are currently done electronically, the bill would require IT changes, as well as additional staff training necessary for case analysis and customer contacts concerning the related OWI offenses.

For the purposes of this fiscal estimate, the department made the assumption that the felony and misdemeanor conviction history checked within the ten-year period specified under the bill would be the convictions that DMV currently receives notification of. In addition, in order to access and view the records of the other criminal offenses required to now be considered under the bill, it is assumed that DMV would need to establish a new connection to the existing Department of Justice (DOJ) interface system.

The one-time IT costs necessary for DMV to implement the changes under this bill are estimated to cost approximately \$198,510. The additional IT programming costs necessary to establish the connection to the DOJ interface system cannot be determined at this time, due to certain factors unknown currently to DMV.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

After initial implementation it is expected that there would be no significant costs required to operate this system.
