#### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill requires the Department to waive park admission fees for parents or guardians of children enrolled in the 4th grade. In addition, it requires the Department to distribute outdoor activity guides to all public and private schools in the state.

#### Revenues

Based on the number resident annual and senior annual passes sold in FY15 (170,000 and 39,000 respectively) an average of 9% of households in Wisconsin purchase annual park admission stickers. Therefore, assuming that 9% of households in Wisconsin with a 4th grade student (72,100 in 2014) purchase annual passes, the reduction in admission fee revenue is estimated at \$181,700 [(72,100 households  $\times$  9%)  $\times$  \$28]. The reduction of admission fee revenue would be offset by an equivalent amount of funding provided in a new, sum sufficient GPR appropriation.

#### Costs

- 1. Publication and distribution of the visitor activity guide: Assuming that there are 72,100 4th grade students in the state and that the cost per guide is \$0.41, the estimated cost for printing and publishing is \$30,000, with an additional \$9,000 for mailing/postage. It should be noted that the Parks and Recreation Program has given consideration to permanently discontinuing the printed visitor activity guide and moving to an online based format. If this is done, the printing cost per guide would increase.
- 2. Procedures will need to be implemented to process requests and maintain a database of students and families that qualify and those families that have already reached their once per household limit on use of the fee waiver. Each sticker provided free of charge will also need to be tracked for purposes of calculating the sum sufficient amount of general fund dollars to equal the amount of fees waived. Staffing costs are estimated to be one, half-time limited term employee to process requests, track total fees waived, and analyze and maintain data. Assuming an LTE wage/fringe of \$19.00/hr. translates to an estimated cost of \$10,000.

### **Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

The impact to Parks SEG and GPR in subsequent years may fluctuate with 4th grade enrollments and because of the provision that limits the fee waiver to 1 per household regardless of how many children attend the fourth grade.
