## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2015 AB 80 would implement an expedited process for agencies to request the repeal of administrative rules and require that each agency annually report to the Joint Committee for Review of Administrative Rules (JCRAR) on all rules for which authority to promulgate has been eliminated or restricted. The bill retains authority under s. 227.15 (4), Stats, requiring the Legislative Council to notify JCRAR whenever the rule-making authority of an agency is eliminated or significantly changed by the repeal, amendment or creation of a statute, by the interpretive decision of a court of competent jurisdiction or for any other reason. The bill would also require the Department to review every legislative enactment and assign the enactment for review by each agency that the Department determines is impacted. The assigned agency must review and determine if the enactment eliminates/restricts/otherwise impacts their admin rule authority. If there is an impact, the agency must take certain actions within 60 days (e.g., submit a statement of scope).

The Department currently provides for notification and tracking functions relating to Gubernatorial approval of administrative rule scope statements, and other enterprise-wide legislative tracking functions (e.g., legislative fiscal estimates).

The Department estimates workload associated with implementing a notification and tracking system, analyzing all legislative enactments and preparation/submittal of the Department's annual report to JCRAR. The costs associated with this workload would be \$27,200 in annual costs, consisting primarily of costs associated with 0.3 FTE, and \$5,000 in one-time costs, consisting primarily of system development costs.
