Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill provides funding for the farm to school grant program in the 2015-2017biennium to the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP). The grant program was originally authorized in the 2009 Wisconsin Act 293 but has never been funded.

Original estimates from the 2009 Wisconsin Act 293 estimated approximately 10-15 grants would be funded if \$200,000 in funding was appropriated. Given the proposed annual funding level of \$125,000, it is assumed DATCP would issue 8-12 grants annually.
