## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

HEAB would provide grants to eligible students to cover tuition and other fees along with housing and textbook costs using a median per student figure at any UW institution or college campus; any technical college; or tribal college. A student is eligible is they are a resident; enrolled at least half-time in a public institution; has completed counseling explaining the program; and signs an agreement that includes a promise to graduate with a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 and a promise to be continuously employed, subject to certain grace periods, within this state for at least three years after graduation. The student would be eligible for the grant their sophomore year and the grant amount is the amount of the student's tution and other educational expenses after other financial aid in the form of grant and scholarships has been applied; based on the tuition and expenses level in the student's first year of enrollment. The grant would be available for four semesters or 60 credits. If the student does not comply with the agreement then the grant becomes a loan and must be repaid at an interest rate of 5% annually.
