Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Assembly Bill 970 prohibits discrimination based on personal health care choices. The bill defines "personal health care choices" as decisions made by, or on behalf of, an individual or family member of an individual related to pregnancy, contraception, reproductive health, including the decision to use or access, or to refrain from the use or access of a particular drug, device, or medical service. AB 970 specifies that discrimination on the basis of health care choices occurs when an employer, labor organization, employment agency, licensing agency, or any person refuses to hire, employ, admit, license, promote, or fires an individual due to these health care choices.

It is projected that this bill would have no significant ongoing fiscal effect on the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development. Administratively DWD could absorb new discrimination complaints arising from the changes without hiring added Equal Rights officers to investigate them. A one-time cost of \$5,000 is needed to reprint existing discrimination documentation.
