Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill removes the current annual limit on the total amount of town expenditures for material and equipment for the construction and maintenance of highways. Under current law, this limit may be exceeded only if exceeding the limit is authorized by the town meeting or by referendum at a town election. By eliminating the need to have a town meeting or a referendum at a town election to exceed the expenditure limit, any costs associated with having a town meeting or referendum will then not be incurred by the town.
