Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill allows for the transfer of certain hunting and fishing approvals to a disabled person. A disabled person is defined as a person who holds a Class A, Class B, Class C, or Class D disabled permit. This bill also allows for the transfer of a Class A bear license to a service member or a person awarded a Purple Heart medal.

Permit transfers are handled administratively and as such, there will be no cost to update the Department's Automated License Issuance System (ALIS). Under this bill, the Department will receive more applications to transfer approvals and will incur additional expense in staff time processing these applications. The increase in staff time for processing transfer applications is indeterminate at this time, as we cannot determine the number of permits that individuals will opt to transfer to disabled persons, service members or Purple Heart recipients.
