Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill makes it unlawful to place a global positioning device on a person's vehicle without their knowledge. In addition, it would be unlawful to place such a device on a vehicle used primarily by the spouse after a petition to end the marriage had been filed.

Should this bill be enacted, prosecutors do not expect there to be a fiscal impact on their offices because current offenders have been prosecuted under existing statutes.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Prosecutors do not anticipate a long-term fiscal impact on their offices should this bill be enacted.
