As soon as the IT costs are identified, DSPS will submit an amendment to this fiscal estimate.

UPDATED 10/22/15: Information Technology costs have been identified. There will be costs associated with making changes to the OLAS system to accommodate the fee proration. Framework to apply the proration method universally.

UPDATED 11/03/15: This legislation is estimated to reduce revenues in the amount of \$1.6 million over the two-year biennium period.
